

Addendum to “Your Health. Our Hospitality.”

Due to the uncontrolled spread of COVID-19 and following the MN Governor’s Executive Order 20-99, Mount Olivet Conference & Retreat Center will limit its residential programming and events to private retreats and outdoor recreation. This will begin on November 20, 2020 and continue for one month or until new guidelines are issued. Here are the details:

- Private overnight and day retreats for people in the same household can be booked throughout this period of time. Full dining service will be provided and meals will be delivered to your conference room or overnight accommodations room.
